Introduction

Sacred Heart College is a Catholic co-educational College in the Mercy tradition which will educate approximately 890 Year 7-12 students in 2025. The school was established in Kyneton in 1889 by the Sisters of Mercy and has educated generations of students from the Macedon Ranges.

The College sits on 20 acres of land between High St and the Campaspe River with approximately 120 teaching and non-teaching staff. In the last two years, the College has completed a new Strategic Plan (2023 – 2026) and is about to launch a Master Plan to guide capital development and refurbishment for the next ten years.
